SECTION 2 - HAY
Premiums: \$3.00 \$2.50 \$2.00

Long Hay only. An exhibit shall consist of a bale section at least eight inches thick or an equivalent amount if cut from in the mow.

- 5600 Alfalfa or Alfalfa Grass mixed first cuttings, not over 50% of grasses.
- 5601 Alfalfa or Alfalfa Grass mixed later cuttings, not over 50% of grasses.
- 5602 Other Legumes or Legume Grass mixture, not over 50% of grasses.
- 5603 Grass, first cutting, mixture of timothy and/or grasses containing not more than 10% legumes.
- 5604 Grass, second cutting, mixture of timothy and/or grasses containing not more than 10% legumes.
- 5605 Mixed Hay, any mixture not classified in the previous classes, but which contains 50% or more singly or in combination with alfalfa, timothy, clover or grasses.
- 5606 Summer Annual Grasses, Sudan grass, Sorghum-Sudan, Hybrids, etc.
- 5607 Grand Champion Hay Exhibit

SECTION 3 - SILAGE
Premiums: \$2.50 \$1.75 \$1.25

Silage Crop must be named. Exhibits shall consist of 10 pounds. Large-size plastic bags are excellent containers for transporting or showing samples.

- 5610 Perennial Crops, direct cut, with or without preservatives
- 5611 Perennial Crops, wilted or low moisture, with or without preservatives.
- 5612 Annuals other than Corn, direct cut, with or without preservatives.
- 5613 Annuals other than Corn, wilted or low moisture, with or without preservatives.
